As a member we ask that you:

- Act in the best interests of the ABF and its current and potential beneficiary community
- Uphold and defend the ABF's vision, mission, and values.
- Promote equality, diversity and inclusion in the acting and stage professions, and treat others with respect, including current and potential beneficiaries and all ABF employees.
- Not disclose confidential information received during the Annual General Meeting, committee meetings, or in any other ABF meetings or communications.
- Immediately inform the chief executive or an officer of the ABF in the event of allegations that would reasonably be considered of concern from a safeguarding perspective or of criminal behaviour, or criminal proceedings or allegations pertinent to the ABF community.
- Keep the ABF informed of your current contact details.
